Workshop Description:

Drawing on the disciplines of playback theatre, improvisation and narrative, this workshop has participants telling, inventing, sharing and hearing stories of all kinds. This ancient tradition of storytelling is how humans learn and make sense of one another, and the worlds we inhabit. The workshop aims is to assist communities (for example, Chinese and Australians) to articulate their own story through performance. Participants will experience new ways of thinking, seeing and feeling, thus enhancing their communication skills in active listening and speaking.

These skills help create deeper bonding within a group and help team building. These are fun, safe, theatre-based workshops designed to develop trust through creative play, music and the use of stories from our own lives.
